Executive Director's Note

The Working Interview

By Chris Klimecko

Seems harmless enough. You have a good candidate for an opening in your practice and you'd like to check out their skills first-hand before hiring them. So you bring her or him in, possibly with no pay, to work for a day. During that time, you get to observe their work. Sounds good. But is this a proper methodology for hiring? In a nutshell, no. Generally speaking, working interviews such as this are not permitted. Below are four common working interview approaches and why they must be avoided.

Without Pay

Let's assume the individual agrees to work for the day without pay. They even sign something that says they're okay with it. Sounds good, but the Department of Labor says that a document of this nature isn't valid. In a nutshell, you can't sign away your right to be paid for a day's work.

With Pay

You decide you'll pay the individual for the day. You agree to an amount, pay them for the day, and record the pay on an IRS Form 1099. Again, sounds like a good way to go. However, there are several things lacking with this method. First and foremost is the USCIS Form I-9

(Employment Eligibility Verification). The Department of Homeland Security requires that all US employers maintain an I-9 for each employee. Beyond the I-9, there's the issue of withholding taxes, the fact that this individual will not be recorded on the NYS



45 (Quarterly Combined Withholding, Wage Reporting, and Unemployment Insurance Return), and a host of other problems.

The Independent Contractor

Going the route of classifying the individual as an independent contractor will not work. According to the IRS:

"The general rule is that an individual is an independent contractor if the payer has the right to control or direct only the result of the work and not what will be done and how it will be done."

Focus on Ethics

Q: I see print advertisements whereby a dentist claims to be a "leader" in a certain aspect of dentistry. Are claims such as this ethical?


A: The test for these types of advertisements is: what a reasonably prudent patient would be likely to believe from seeing an advertisement, not what the most foolish person might be misled by or what the wisest person would know not to be deceived by.

You may recall that I reported on a similar case at the Executive Council meeting in November 2015. In that case, there was a claim in a print ad that stated: "when you care to send them to the very best." No reasonable consumer would assume that the dentists were the "very best" of all dentists.

In the present complaint, the idea that a reasonable consumer would react with: "I never realized that this dentist is a true leader and other dentists lack leadership skills and are inferior to this dentist" is not realistic. This is so small in scale that no sensible consumer would be misled by it.

In addition, a certain amount of leeway has to be allowed in terms of advertising puffery. If a certain amount of creativity or license is not allowed, then all advertising in dentistry would be neutered in such a way that it is simply dry recitations of information.

I see nothing wrong with the use of that term in that context.

"You are not an independent contractor if you perform services that can be controlled by an employer (what will be done and how it will be done). This applies even if you are given freedom of action. What matters is that the employer has the legal right to control the details of how the services are performed."

Residents

Residents are not licensed dentists and therefore cannot work outside the scope of their respective program.

There are alternatives to the working interview that can provide similar results. For more information on what's permitted in this area, contact the Legal Affairs area at NYSDA (1-800-255-2100), an attorney, or a human resources professional.


2016 ADA Annual Session




