Dr. Auster's series of articles in Dentistry Today is entitled "Conquering a Difficult Case". His October 2015 article in Inside Dentistry entitled "Cosmetic Dentistry for Patients with Bulimia" discusses the role dentists can play in potentially saving the lives of patients with eating disorders in addition to revitalizing their smiles. He recently became a Dawson Scholar and received a Concept of Complete Dentistry Award from the Dawson Academy. Dr. Auster's volunteer work includes 9 years of volunteer dentistry in Jamaica; Give Back a Smile; ADA Donated Dental Services; and Smiles for Life, in which his office has contributed over \$40,000 to children's charities in the past 3 years. He has received a Certificate for International Voluntary Service from the ADA. Dr. Auster is a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine.
